NATIONAL DESIGN TRIENNIAL TO FEATURE ARTĚL'S GLACIER VASE

PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC – Artěl Glass is now on show at America's most cutting-edge design exhibition, the *National Design Triennial* at the Cooper-Hewitt Museum.

Artěl's Glacier Vase will be part of an exhibit highlighting the work of rising American design star, David Wiseman. Designed by Wiseman and entirely hand made by Artěl's team of Czech artisans, the Glacier Vase puts a subtle twist on designs found in the natural world.

The National Design Triennial brings together experimental designs and emerging ideas at the center of American culture. This position clearly echoes the innovative work of Wiseman and Artěl – both designers who infuse traditional art forms with contemporary panache, creating modern classics.

In addition to the Glacier Vase, Wiseman will exhibit several other designs including vases in various materials and his cherry blossom ceiling installation in porcelain, bronze and plaster.

This year's triennial marks the second time in two years Artěl has been exhibited at the Cooper-Hewitt Museum. In 2004, a collection of four tumblers designed by Sol LeWitt and manufactured by Artěl were featured as part of the *Design ≠ Art* exhibit.

Design Life Now: National Design Triennial 2006, is exhibiting at the Cooper-Hewitt, National Design Museum in New York until July 29, 2007.
